What is a Grand of Distinction?

In 2011, the CFA created a new title – the Grand of Distinction.

For cats to be able to earn this title, they must receive a total of 30 finals during each show season for three (3) separate show seasons. These show seasons do not need to be consecutive and can be earned in either Championship or Premiership. The finals also cannot have more than ten (10) specialty rings counted towards the finals.

Cats that show for this title earn this title through a love of cat shows, for being handled, and for being in great condition.



Earned During the 2015-2016 Show Year









